Who is allowed to study Swedish for immigrants (SFI) in Nacka Municipality?

Anyone who signs up for SFI in Nacka Municipality must be registered in Nacka, have received their full personal identity number (10 digits) and must be at least 18 years old.

All students set to begin studying SFI in Nacka should come to the Work- and Business Unit which is located in Nacka town hall, and apply at the reception.

There, you will fill in an SFI form, get information about the various SFI schools and receive assistance with the SFI application on the internet at www.nacka.se. If you are applying for a continuation course at SFI, you do not need to contact us at the Work- and Business Unit, but apply at www.nacka.se.

May I study Swedish for immigrants (SFI) in Nacka if I live in another municipality?

If you are registered in another municipality and want to take courses in Nacka, you should print and submit your application to your municipality, which needs to approve the courses you have applied for. There is always a special box on the printed application form where your municipality needs to make a statement.

Can I register for the SFI course after the application deadline?

The adult education in Nacka does not have any application deadline.

Can I change SFI schools?

If you wish to change SFI schools, you should first contact the school that you already are attending and ask the school to register a suspension for you in our IT system. You can then apply for a new school at www.nacka.se

SFI schools and class hours?

Nacka municipality has several SFI schools, of which some are situated in Nacka, and some in other places in Stockholm County.

Most schools offer lessons both during daytime and in the evenings. Some schools also offer distance courses.

Is there an education in Swedish (SFI) for people with professional education?

If you have a foreign professional education, you can study SFI with a focus on your profession. You can find more information about this at Swedish for professionals, SFX, which is a collaboration between all municipalities in Stockholm County. When will I be notified if I have been admitted to the SFI course that I have applied for?

You will find information about your application by logging in to My Page. The school that you have applied for will send you an admission decision.

Does it cost anything to study SFI at the Adult Education?

All lessons at all schools within the adult education of Nacka are free of charge. The course books that are used in classes and copy fees are paid by you.

Who makes the assessment of my foreign grades?

The Swedish Agency for Higher Education Services, VHS, assesses all foreign upper secondary school grades. You can find more information at www.vhs.se. In need of special support?

If you have a disability and need extra support in order for your studies to function well, you can specify this when registering for the course and communicate this to the school you are going to attend.
